Flamingo Flocking



The PFUMC Youth Group is working to raise funds to go to Orlando, FL, for a mission trip this summer by holding a Flamingo Flocking Fund Raiser.

How does Flocking Work? During spring break, on weekends until school is out, and continuing this summer, you can "flock" a church member for a minimum suggested donation of \$25. Upon receipt of the order form and your donation, the youth group (with adult chaperones) will secretly place a flock of flamingos on the "victim's" front yard. Birds will be delivered after dark on the day desired, depending on the availability of the flock. The birds will "roost" in the yard for no more than 24 hours. The flock will carry a note that explains the removal and forward ordering information.

Flamingo Removal: Flamingos will be removed from your yard by the Youth Group within 24 hours of their placement, whether you choose to make a donation or not. You can forward them to another unsuspecting "victim" for a \$25 donation. How To Avoid Being Flocked: If you would like to prevent the Pink Flamingos from landing in your yard, Anti-Flocking Insurance is available for the very low price of \$20.00. This insurance will guarantee that the flock will not take up residence in your yard during the 2008 season.

The removal does not require payment, but a donation to benefit the Power's Ferry UMC Youth Group's trip to Orlando, FL, would be greatly appreciated. When choosing a person to flock, be wary of their temperament and sense of humor. Do not choose someone who would abuse the flamingos by shoving them into a garage, etc., or who, heaven forbid, might call the police!
